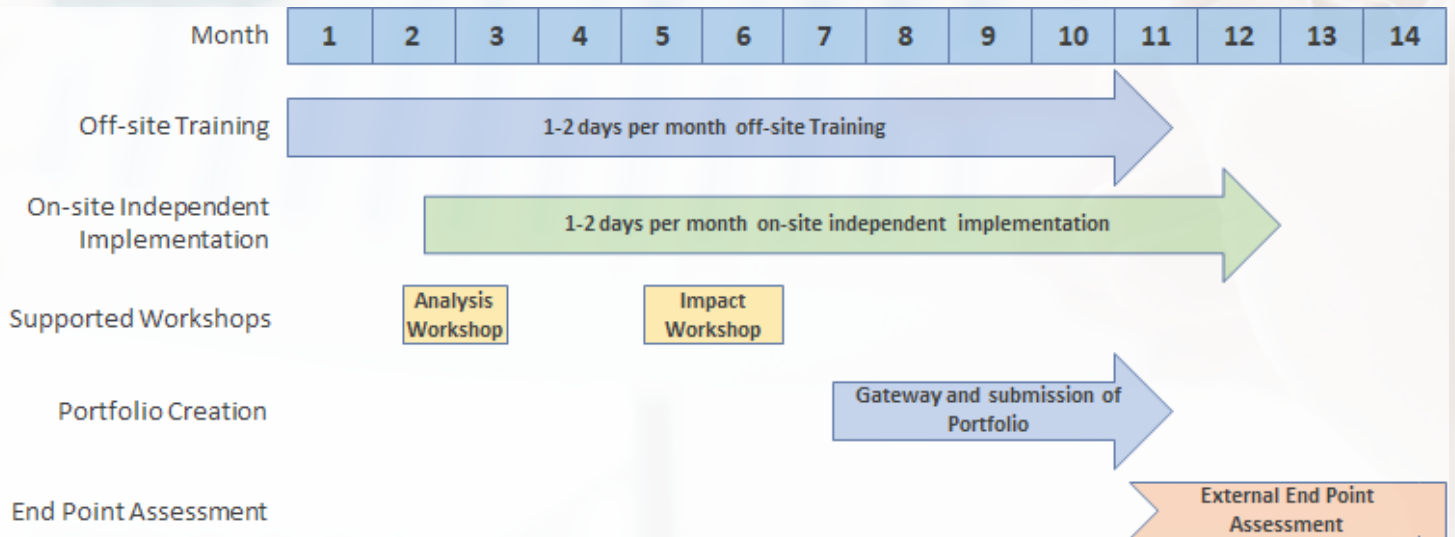

APPRENTICESHIP LEVY FUNDED

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Roughly equivalent to Lean Six Sigma Yellow, Green, Black and Master Black Belts, the 4 Improvement Apprenticeships are open to both existing and new employees. If you pay into the Levy, then the courses are 100% funded. If you are lucky enough to not have to pay into the levy, you can still get 95% funding.

With over 20 years experience of delivering on-site improvement, LI Europe has created a unique approach that combines Kaizen Workshop style Block Learning with Continuous Learning throughout the year. This way apprentices are able to deliver real £££ bottom line results to the business as part of their apprenticeship.



Apprentices are trained in Cohorts of 6-12 people, with typically 3 different (non-competing) companies represented in each Cohort.

Minimum group size per company starts at 3 Improvement Technicians, or 2 Improvement Practitioners or Specialists.

Start times are flexible throughout the year, based on suitable Cohorts arising in each region.

- 2 days per month learning and implementation
- 10 day "Analysis" workshop in month 2 to identify major opportunities to improve
- 20 day "Impact" workshop in month 5-6 to implement actual improvements
- Months 7-12 focussed on sustainability and effecting behavioural change
